

We have just about made it through the very hottest of the riding season and cooler weather is on the horizon. Of course, that means the rains are also approaching but I am proud to be a member of a club whose members ride skillfully -- rain or shine, hot or cold, day or night, hard or even harder. We are all guided by the words displayed on one of our most popular raffle prize tee shirts: "Fill. Ride. Repeat." Those are truly words to live (and to ride) by.

About two dozen RCB members participated in the BEEMER BASH up in Quincy. In addition, the Club sponsored the Poker Run at the event as a favor to our sister club from Central Cal. Ken crafted a wonderful route that drew unanimous praise from the riders. We sold enough poker hands to completely cover the \$400 in prizes that we distributed. In my view, even if we had to subsidize some of the prize money it would have been a good investment in inter-club relations. The folks at CCR were very, very appreciative of RCB's willingness to handle all the details (and the financing) of the poker run. RCB has already been invited to organize the poker run at next year's BASH. Perhaps this can be the beginning of closer cooperation between the two clubs on other events that might be too complicated or too expensive to do as individual clubs. We'll see what (if anything) develops.

Regarding our own Club events.....As you read this we will have just held our first Fall Classic (Cloverdale Edition). The Board decided to experiment with the idea of rotating the Fall Classic annually between the Manchester Beach and Cloverdale KOA's to inject some meteorological and geographic diversity. Please let me or another Board member know what you thought of the new location after the inaugural Cloverdale

Edition. Obviously, we will not continue the "location rotation" if – after this experiment -- our members prefer to hold the event at the same place every year (whether that's Manchester, Cloverdale, or even someplace else).

More generally, members are encouraged to take an active role in the Club's activities. If you have an idea for an event, please let me know. If you want to take the initiative and actually organize an event – EVEN BETTER! Last year, one of our members stepped up and proposed AND organized the Samuel P. Taylor Oyster Run in June. It was great success and it looks like the event will become an annual entry on our riding calendar. Attending the annual planning meeting (scheduled for Sunday, November 18 at 5pm) is the easiest way for members to get involved in suggesting and approving events for next year's calendar. (BTW: It's also an opportunity for some free pizza and a cold one!) You can be certain some hardy perennials (e.g., Ride 'n' Bowl, Tahoe Chill, Lois Lewis Memorial Poker Run, Rider Skills Improvement Day, Fall Classic, Christmas Party, et al.) will continue, but it is up to active members to come up with new ideas for events to complete our offerings for next year.

Members can also impact the direction of the Club going forward by becoming a Club officer or by participating in the monthly Board meetings (either as a Board member or simply by attending the meetings to express your views). New officers and Board members will be elected at the November monthly meeting. The Club officers and Board represent the membership and all of us do our best to come up with ideas and events to support and advance our shared love of all things related to motorcycling. Your participation and help in those efforts is essential and genuinely welcomed.

Ride often, ride safely, ride hard, ride purposefully, and keep those air vests UNinflated!


